- Total books distributed YTD = 541,331
- Total books distributed 2021 over 2020 88,288
- 2022 goals
 - 600K books distributed
 - Targeted districts: Wyandanch, Westbury, Washington Hts. requires 73K books so every child gets 10 books a year.
 - Community book fairs: 220K books 11 fairs/year
 - Order delivery/pick up: 100K books
 - Ongoing deliveries: 57k books to LIRR, correctional facilities, pediatric centers
 - Overseas: 150K books depending on our partner and shipping abilities

Proposed statement: The Books Fairies sources and redistributes books to underresourced communities on Long Island and NYC to provide equitable opportunities for children to learn, grow, and thrive.

Vision Statement: All children have equitable access to books so they can learn, grow, and thrive.

Concerns:

- 1. Geography: Primary service area is Long Island and NYC. Global is a secondary benefit, not part of our main mission. Regarding greater NY area: we do not service New Jersey, Rockland, Westchester, etc.
- 2 Equality vs Equity: Equitable is preferable to using the word "equal". Equity: level the playing field by making sure underserved populations have access to resources and opportunities that can close the achievement gaps.
- 3 Change "underserved" to "under-resourced"
