





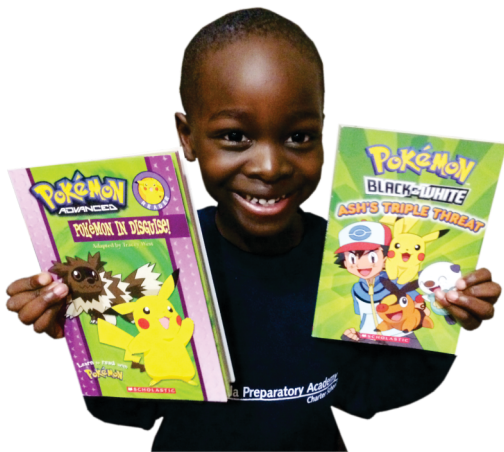

By increasing access to high interest books in underprivileged communities, The Book Fairies is committed to breaking the cycle of poverty that stems from illiteracy.

DID YOU KNOW?

-  \$232 billion a year in health care costs is lost to low adult literacy skills
-  75% of prison inmates are functionally illiterate
-  80% of pre-schools and after school programs serving children in need do not have a single book for the children they serve
-  94% of teachers use their own money to provide books & resources for their students
-  1 in 4 New Yorkers are functionally illiterate
-  64% of all 4th graders in NYS read below grade level; data shows 2/3 of those students will likely end up in jail or on welfare



The Book Fairies is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization that fights to end the cycle of poverty by distributing donated reading materials to underserved communities, which, in turn enhances literacy, improves confidence, and fosters academic success.

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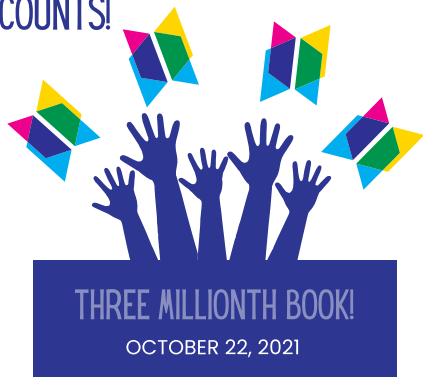

IMPACT IN 2020 INCLUDING COVID-19 RELIEF

-  453,678 total books distributed to under-privileged schools and nonprofits in 2020
-  17 socially distanced School Book Fairs, with 8,117 books distributed, impacting 5,795 children
-  Partnered with 34 day habilitation and prevocational programs to engage special needs individuals
-  11.62 tons of books recycled, helping to save over 200 trees and 35.4 yards of landfill space
-  78,260 books distributed through our overseas partnerships to build libraries in



OUR PROGRAMS

Community Book Fairs

Educators from high-needs schools and community organizations “shop” The Book Fairies’ warehouse for free books to supplement classroom libraries, support curriculum, and build home libraries.

School Book Fairs

The Book Fairies hosts school book fairs at under-served schools, allowing children to select high-interest books to start their own home library.

Community Distribution

The Book Fairies provides books to support community outreach programs with our ongoing bookshelves. These bookshelves are hosted at soup kitchens, hospitals, correctional facilities, homeless shelters, senior centers, foster care, social service organizations, and more.

Special Needs Partnership Program

The Book Fairies offers 180 opportunities a week to foster community service and engagement for special needs individuals.

Global Literacy Initiative

The Book Fairies donates books to overseas partners who are building libraries in developing countries, including Ghana, Nigeria, South Africa, Zimbabwe, and Kenya.

Host a fundraiser to support our “literacy” program.
